It offers a comfortable and friendly bar and bistro with the restaurant area opening out to the Lindauer Lawn, with spectacular views towards the Southern Alps.

Situated within the footprint of Addington Raceway, AMI Stadium and CBS Arena (both a short walk across the car park) it offers the ideal place for a pre-concert or pre-game meal (with special show night dining and game day menus), large screens showing all the major sporting fixtures and race track views.

There are a variety of menus to suit the time of day but it's on the evening menu that you will find their "big AZZZ burger". It covers a large plate and if you can get through it by yourself and still want more, the fries are on the house. ## HEY REFI!

The FIVB have changed the use of the official hand signals that are used by the 2nd referee. Now if the decision is made by the 1st referee, it is no longer necessary for the 2nd Referee to "mirror" the signals of the 1st Referee. The second referee is just required to move to the side of the next receiving team. If the 2nd referee calls a fault they will indicate the nature of the fault and then the player at fault if required.

## PVL Reminders:

Remember that the minimum requirement for duty is 5 people and at least a theory qualified 1st referee.

Failure to meet these requirements will result in the loss of competition points.

All athletes that are written on the score sheet are required to be registered with CVA on your team list.
